The San Joaquin Potters Guild has a fall Fine Arts Festival each year. This event provides a great opportunities to sell your clay or glass art. Members receive reduced rates for booths at this festival. Currently we have an annual pit fire and other member shows at venues to provide opportunities to sell your art. Through networking with members, you will find out about many other opportunities to take advantage of area including juried events.
