### Annual Events and Opportunities

- ◆ The San Joaquin Potters Guild has a fall Fine Arts Festival each year. This event provides a great opportunity to sell your clay or glass art. Members receive reduced rates for booths at this festival. All member and non-member participants are juried in the Fine Arts Festival.
- ◆ Currently, we have a member only annual pit fire and can participate in the featured artists at the Stockton Art League one-month a year. We are also seeking other gallery member featured artist shows.
